The rule was initially intended to specify residency requirements, as well as standards, guidelines, and procedures for the receipt, processing and administration of loans under the program. The program last received an appropriation in FY02, and is not operational with the exception of several accounts that are in default/collections. The provisions in the administrative rule relating to the servicing of the loan are duplicated in the promissory notes that each of these borrowers signed, rendering the administrative rule obsolete.
