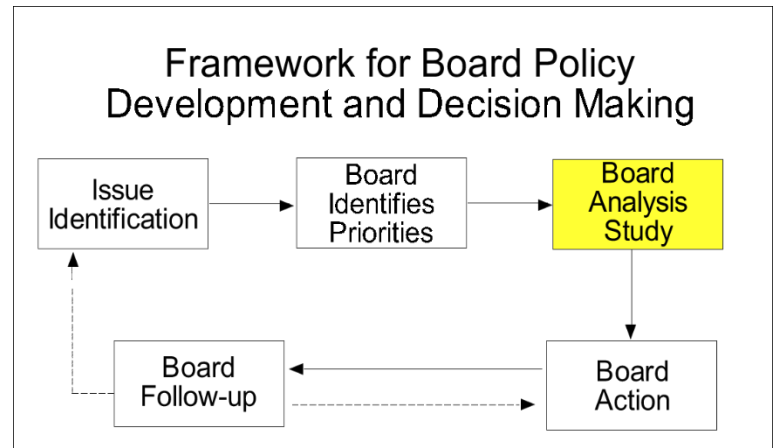

Overview of Standards and Practices

State Board Priority: Promote equity in education by closing achievement and opportunity gaps.

State Board Role/Authority: The State Board of Education is the sole authorizer for Iowa's charter schools. Iowa charter school law (256E and 256F) and Iowa Administrative Code 281.19 requires the State Board of Education to use nationally recognized best practices for charter school authorizing.

Background: Quality charter school authorizing requires specialized knowledge, skill, commitment, and adherence to essential professional standards in order to effectively deliver quality educational opportunities for students and communities, and achieve the purposes of state charter laws.
