





# Language Translation Guide

Website content can be translated into your preferred language. To view web content in your preferred language, you must first select your preferred language in your internet browser settings. This process varies by internet browser.

## Google Chrome

- Open Google Chrome browser.
- At the top right, select **More Settings**. 
- Select **Languages**.
- Under “Google Translate,” select **Translate into this language** and select preferred language from the list.
- Turn **Use Google Translate** on or off.

## Microsoft Edge

- Open Microsoft Edge browser.
- Select the 3 dots icon in the upper right corner. 
- Select **Settings**, then select **Languages** to update your Preferred Language(s).

## Mozilla Firefox

- Open Mozilla Firefox browser.
- Download the [Firefox Translation add-on](#).
- Click **Add to Firefox** and select **Add** to install it to your browser.

## Safari

- Open the Apple menu icon then go to **System Settings**. 
- Click **General**  in the sidebar, then click **Language & Region**.
- Choose your preferred language(s).
