Ms. Walrod applied for reinstatement on 7 February 3, 2025 and she is eligible to apply for reinstatement. Ms. Walrod has met 8 the timeline of the suspension and fulfilled the requirements of her disciplinary order. 9 Ms. Walrod was not present before the Board. Eric St Clair moved, with a second by 10 Davis Eidahl to grant the application for reinstatement as the reason for the 11 suspension no longer exists and reinstatement is in the public interest. In 2024, there were 311 complaints received and 347 went before the board. 2025 is off to a good start with almost double the amount of complaints going 31 32 before the board compared to new complaints received.
