2. **Rationale** Describe the rationale for the language revision from 1A to 1B. Provide sufficient detail to explain the need for the amendment.

After securing a letter of intent on March 4, 2025 regarding the lease for the proposed school site at 20525 Monument Road, ultimately the terms offered in the lease were untenable. Delays with the lease affected hiring and meant most teachers were already under contract for the 2025-26 school year. The RBS needs to have time to have a broad outreach for staff recruitment. Additional operating funds were needed. We raised over \$117,000 through community contributions and fundraising events in merely 3 months. However, the RBS was still short of the financing needs of \$200,000 to cover staffing and operation costs prior to September 2025.

3. **Desired Outcome** Describe the desired outcome of the amendment.

Amend the opening date until August 2026. Permit additional time to secure a new, permanent site.

4. Best Practices Describe how previous practices that led to the established contract language (1A) will change to support the current amended language (1B). How will the charter ensure effective implementation of the proposed amendment?

RBS is seeking a permanent school site to provide stability and sustainability. Three sites are identified as potential Crescent City limits sites and other county sites will be examined in order to select the appropriate site to complement our nature-art and community concepts. The time extension will allow us to work with AEA consultants to recruit top principal and educators early in the year. The school is continuing to pursue donations and grant funding to address gap in operating funds.
