A Day at the Dairy Farm

- Do you know where milk comes from? A Dairy Farm!
- Let's go on a field trip to learn about what happens on a dairy farm!
- <u>Hop</u> on the bus and <u>squat down</u> in your seat. Look out the window at all of the fields and farms going by.
- Here we are. <u>Stand up</u> and <u>walk</u> off of the bus. Let's <u>put on</u> some big boots.
- <u>Walk</u> out to the barn. Cows need to be milked twice a day. First thing in the morning and in the afternoon. Most dairy farms use machines, but let's practice milking a cow by hand. <u>Squat down</u> onto a milking stool. To <u>milk</u> the cow squeeze your hands and move them up and down.
- Carefully <u>carry</u> the bucket to the large holding tank. <u>Pour</u> the bucket of milk into a big tank. The milk will be sent to the dairy to be processed before it goes to the store.
- We need to feed the cows. Use a pitch fork to <u>scoop</u> some hay. Then give them a scoop full of grain in the cow's trough.
- Finally, let's clean up the milking barn. Get a big broom and <u>sweep</u> the floors. Now take the water hose and <u>spray</u> everything down moving the hose from left to right and from top to bottom.
- Whew! That was a lot of work; let's <u>stretch</u> out our arms and legs and then <u>walk</u>back to the bus. I am ready to relax and enjoy a cold glass of milk!
