

NAEP 2024 Iowa Results

The National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) is the only nationally representative, ongoing assessment of what U.S. students know and can do in various subjects. Because NAEP assessments are administered uniformly using the same testing format nationwide, the results provide a common metric for all states and selected urban districts.

The assessment remains mostly the same from year to year, with only carefully documented changes. This permits NAEP to provide a clear picture of student academic progress over time.

Note: NAEP uses separate scoring scales for each subject **and** content areas within a subject. Therefore, scores should not be compared across subjects and grade levels.
