

2025–26 State Scholarship & Grant Quick Reference Guide

The Quick Reference Guide provides a brief overview of the general student eligibility criteria for state scholarship and grant programs as well as general state processing guidelines.

All Iowa Opportunity Scholarship

Students with financial need who attend college within two years of graduating high school.

- FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application due April 1.
- Priority given to students in foster care, children of deceased public safety workers, participants in TRIO programs, students in alternative high schools/alternative programs, and GEAR UP students.
- SAI at or below \$10,669.
- Enroll in 3 or more semester hours (or equivalent).
- Maximum award – \$5,334.

Education Training Voucher

Students who age out of foster care or were previously in foster care and legally adopted after age 16.

- FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application due December 1.
- Enroll in 3 or more semester hours (or equivalent).
- Maximum award – \$5,000

Iowa National Guard Service Scholarship

Students who are members of the Iowa Army National Guard or Air National Guard.

- FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application required.
- Priority Deadline:
 - Fall Deadline – July 1.
 - Spring Deadline – December 1.
- Apply for Federal Tuition Assistance (if applicable)
- Maximum award – \$9,296.

Iowa Tuition Grant – Not for Profit

Students who attend a non-profit private university.

- FAFSA required – due July 1.
- SAI at or below \$16,000.
- Enroll in 3 or more semester hours (or equivalent).
- Maximum award – \$7,500.

Iowa Vocational-Technical Tuition Grant

Students enrolled in career and technical education programs at community colleges.

- FAFSA required – due July 1.
- Enroll in 3 or more semester hours (or equivalent).
- SAI range of \$201 to \$6,800.
- Maximum award – \$1,000.
 - Award on a sliding scale based on SAI.

Kibbie Grant

Students enrolled in specified career and technical education programs at community colleges.

- FAFSA required – due July 1.
- Enroll in 3 or more semester hours (or equivalent).
- SAI at or below \$6,000.
- Maximum award – \$3,000.
 - Award on a sliding scale based on SAI.

Future Ready Iowa Last-Dollar Scholarship

Students enrolled in high demand areas attending associate program or below.

- FAFSA required – due December 31.
- SAI at or below \$20,000 (new recipients only)
- Enroll in 6 or more semester hours (or equivalent)
- Maximum award – Tuition and institution wide fees.

Future Ready Iowa Grant

Students enrolled in high demand areas in bachelors programs.

- FAFSA and Iowa Financial Aid Application required. – due July 1.
- Enroll in 6 or more semester hours (or equivalent)
- Maximum award – \$3,000.

Workforce Grant & Incentive Program

Students enrolled in high demand areas and attending the University of Iowa, Iowa State University, or University of Northern Iowa.

- FAFSA required. – due July 1.
- SAI at or below \$7,000
- Enroll in 3 or more semester hours (or equivalent)
- Maximum award – \$2,000
