

# FBA/BIP Changes in ACHIEVE

This document provides a brief overview of the more notable changes to the Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA) and Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP) processes in ACHIEVE. Please refer to the *Updates to FBA and BIP Processes in ACHIEVE* document for more detailed information.

## FBA Changes:

- New FBAs will be initiated under the Evaluation stepper, under a **new FBA Management card**.
- Draft FBAs and Draft BIPs can now be **open at the same time**, with information from the draft FBA carried over to the draft BIP in real time.
- If teams have both a draft FBA and draft BIP open at the same time, **both must be completed/finalized before the IEP can be finalized**.
- A new required category of **Lagging Skills** will be entered in the Data Collected sub-stepper of the FBA.
- Two new required sections in the Summary sub-stepper of the FBA will collect **Summary and Convergence of Data** and **Recommendations**.

## BIP Changes:

- The BIP will now be part of the IEP, as a **new stepper**.
- To start a new BIP, users will still navigate to the **Social Emotional Behavior Special Factor section** in the PLAAFP of the IEP, however the selections in this section have been updated.
- The BIP stepper will **automatically update** with any new information entered into the draft FBA.
- During the annual IEP process, teams will have the option to **revise the current BIP, create a new BIP, or discontinue the BIP**.
- Outside of the annual IEP process, the BIP can only be changed through an **IEP amendment**.
- A new required category of **Lagging Skills** will be carried over from the FBA and/or can be identified on the BIP, and strategies for addressing Lagging Skills will be entered in the Strategies sub-stepper of the BIP.
- **Generalization and Fading Plans** are incorporated directly into applicable strategies identified on the BIP Strategies sub-stepper.
