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Requirements

To earn the Purple Star designation, high schools must meet the following requirements:

- Designate a staff member, such as a counselor, teacher or administrator, to serve as a military liaison for students and families.
- Maintain a dedicated webpage with resources tailored to militaryconnected families.
- Host programs and events that raise awareness and provide support for military-connected students.
- Offer staff training focused on the unique challenges military-connected students face.
