

ACHIEVE Progress Monitoring Enhancements: *Questions and Answers*

- No finalized IEPs or progress entries are removed.
- New IEPs (initial or annual) and IEP amendments will include enhanced features.
- New Progress Monitoring fields (Goal Mastery) will appear for every goal.

ACHIEVE is releasing new Progress Monitoring enhancements to improve efficiency, clarity, and data display. This FAQ addresses the questions providers are most likely to ask.

Do I need to redo or recreate any of my draft IEPs or goals?

No. All draft IEPs will automatically incorporate new functionality. New IEPs (initial and annual) will convert once initiated. After changes are released, you will be required to complete Goal Mastery fields on draft IEPs, but **will not need to recreate goals**.

Will any of my progress monitoring data or my graphs be deleted?

No. All historical points, graphs, and existing progress points remain. Graphs may visually refresh to match the new layout, but **no content is lost**.

Why do the graphs look a little different now?

- Graph titles now use Goal Nicknames.
- Milestones appear in the visual timeline.
- “View Graphs” open in a simplified read-only view.

What exactly is changing?

- **Data fields**
 - Goal Nicknames
 - Mastery and Monitoring fields
 - Milestone display
 - Multiple Entry Page
- **Formatting**
 - Draft IEP formatting
 - Service environment minutes
 - Provider placement
 - Progress Reports for correct formatting

What changed on the Service page, and why do the numbers look different?

Display updated only:

- “Gen Ed Removal” is now labeled **Special Education Environment**.
- A new **General Education Environment** column appears.
- Table spacing and provider information fields are cleaner.

All service lines remain. **No minutes or frequencies are deleted.**

Will any of my IFSP logs or IFSP Progress Reports be affected?

- All IFSP service logs remain intact.
- Draft logs convert automatically.
- A new IFSP Progress Report layout becomes available for all IFSPs.
- The Data History timeline will display historical IFSP monitoring where available.
