**Note 1:** Secondary education licensure in English is possible for transfer students to complete within two years at Central College with the English Transfer Major. **Note 2:** Other LIT courses will be considered for credit toward the Elective category in the English major, with the exception of courses in World Literature. Examples include LIT 167, 168, 171, 175, 180, 209, 210, 802, 804, 806. **Note 3:** Students who have completed the English Transfer Major will have the following 6 English requirements to complete at Central College: ENGL 180: The Reader's Toolbox, one 200-level elective, two 300-level electives, ENGL 346: Discovering Shakespeare, and ENGL 425: Seminar in Literary Studies.
