Note: We are funding Grants on a 3 year Grant Cycle to provide a more equitable distribution of federal grant funds. Each Grant is unique, all provide either before and after-school activities, and or summer school but some provide even more services for children. Some provide extensive family literacy activities, backpack food programs, dental care, behavior support and other support systems for the needs of children.
