State-Approved Iowa Evaluator Approval Trainings

The following courses have met the criteria established in [Iowa Code 284.10](#), [Iowa Code 284A.7](#), and [Iowa Administrative Rule 281-83.5](#) for evaluator approval training. There are multiple pathways for professional administrator license renewal (e.g., [Individual Professional Development Plans](#)).

A [professional administrator license renewal](#) requires one of the following:

Option A: Four renewal credits which must include an approved evaluator training course and mandatory reporter training

Option B: Verification of a Master's degree or higher, at least 10 years of PK-12 licensed experience, and the mandatory reporter training. Evaluator training less than 10 years old is also required to renew an administrator or evaluator license.

When considering renewal training, a participant must complete one of the following evaluator approval courses:
