The 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Center grant provides Title IV B funds for to start model afterschool programs. There is an expectation that community partnerships will provide initial support and that partnerships will increase to sustain these programs when the grant ends. 2 CFR 200.331(b) requires states to conduct a risk assessment. Iowa conducts a risk assessment for all grantees before any initial award, and continues risk assessment monitoring throughout the grant cycle.

Note: We are funding Grants on a 3 year Grant Cycle (with an optional 2 year extension after a comprehensive site visit per ESSA) to provide a more equitable distribution of federal funds. Each Grant is unique, all provide either before and after-school activities, and or summer school but some provide even more services for children (full meals, social emotional, health and other whole child services).
