
Career and Technical Education (CTE)

- CTE Participant A postsecondary student who has earned one (1) or more credits within a career and technical education program.
- CTE Concentrator A postsecondary student who has earned at least twelve (12.0)
 Carnegie units within a career and technical education program or program of study; or completed such a program if the program encompasses fewer than 12.0 credits or the equivalent in total.

1P1 Postsecondary Retention & Placement

In the reporting year...The percentage of CTE concentrators who, during the second quarter after program completion, remain enrolled in postsecondary education, are in advanced training, military service, or a service program that receives assistance under title I of the National and Community Service Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12511 et seq.), are volunteers as described in section 5(a) of the Peace Corps Act (22 U.S.C. 2504(a)), or are placed or retained in employment.



Numerator = CTE Concentrators who have completed their program, and two quarters later, remain enrolled in postsecondary education, are in advanced training, military service, community service, or are employed.


Denominator = CTE Concentrators who have completed their program.

Performance = The percentage of CTE Concentrators who have completed their program, and two quarters later, remain enrolled in postsecondary education, are in advanced training, military service, community service, or are employed.

2P1 Earned Recognized Postsecondary Credential

In the prior year... The percentage of CTE concentrators who receive a recognized postsecondary credential during participation in or within 1 year of leaving postsecondary education.



Numerator = CTE Concentrators who receive a recognized postsecondary credential during participation in or within 1 year of leaving postsecondary education.


Denominator = Utilizing a Cohort, CTE Concentrators who left postsecondary education in the reporting period plus those that are still enrolled.

Performance = The percentage of CTE concentrators who receive a recognized postsecondary credential during participation in or within 1 year of leaving postsecondary education.

3P1 Nontraditional Program Concentration

In the reporting year...The percentage of CTE concentrators in career and technical education programs and programs of study that lead to non-traditional fields and who are of the under-represented gender for the field.



Numerator = Students in identified non-traditional programs that are CTE concentrators and are in the under-represented gender.

Denominator = Students in identified non-traditional programs that are CTE Concentrators.

Performance = The percentage of CTE Concentrators in CTE programs that lead to non-traditional fields
