1. Embed WBL and Review WBL Data

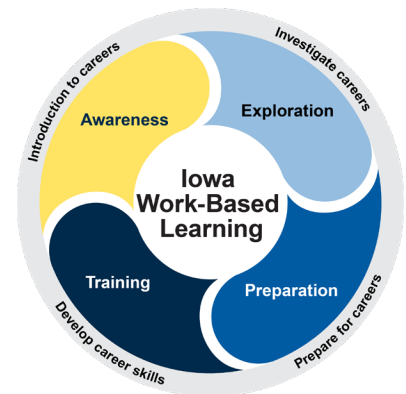
Use the [Work-Based Learning Self-Assessment Tool](#)
