Report Name	Description	Addresses Questions Like...
ASMT 1.1.1 - Individual Student Reports	This report displays a graph and data table of Iowa Assessment subtest results for the selected student and school year, viewable as National Standard Scores (NSS), National Percentile Rankings (NPR), or National Grade Equivalents (NGE).	In which subtests is the student proficient?
ASMT 1.1.2 - Individual Student Assessment - Trend	This report displays a graph and data table of Iowa Assessment subtest results for the selected student over time. The scores are viewable as National Standard Scores, National Percentiles, or National Grade Equivalents.	How has a student's performance over time changed?
ASMT 1.1.3 - Individual Student List by Grade	This report shows a list of students' Iowa Assessment results OR Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) for the selected district and/or school building, depending on the School Year selected in the prompts. Because the data set differs between the Iowa Assessments and the ISASP, prompts and the resulting report output vary slightly.	What is the range of performance on the mathematics test for 5th grade students?
ASMT 1.1.4 - Individual Student List by Grade - NSS Score History	For users with Individual Student Level access, this report provides current and historical access to a list of student's NSS scores beginning with the prompted school year. Exportable to Excel, this is a convenient way to extract lists of students.	Which students grew less than a typical amount between 7th and 8th grade in Reading? (after exporting to Excel and completing some additional steps)
ASMT 1.1.5 - Alternate Assessment	This report displays Alternate Assessment data for the selected student and school year.	In which assessments is the student proficient?
ASMT 1.1.6 - Alternate Assessment - Student List	This report displays a list of students (along with some basic demographic information) that took the Alternate Assessment in Iowa for the selected school year and organization. The report can be run for State, AEA, District, or Building level, depending on the user's security permissions.	What students took at least one Iowa Alternate Assessment subtest?
ASMT 1.1.7 - Alternate Assessment Count by District or AEA	This report displays a count of students that took the Alternate Assessment. The counts can be grouped either by the District name or the AEA name.	How many students (in an AEA or District) took at least one Iowa Alternate Assessment subtest?

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ASMT 1.4 - Assessment Cube Reports	This content folder contains multidimensional analysis cubes, available to users with the appropriate security access and training.	(Useful for ad-hoc querying of assessment-related data).
ASMT 1.5.3 - IELDA Crosstabs	This report displays counts and percentages of IELDA assessment results for the selected location (District or Subgrantee). The counts presented within this report are counts based on students' subtest scores, grouped by Subtest and Grade Level.	How many students took the IELDA at a district?
ASMT 1.5.4 - ELPA21 List	This report is designed to show a list of students' ELPA21 results for the selected organization in a selected school year. The report can be run at a Subgrantee, District, Public or Nonpublic School, depending on the user's security permissions.	Which students took the ELPA21 summative assessment at my building last year?
ASMT 1.5.5 - ELPA21 Crosstabs	This report displays ELPA21 counts and percentages for the selected location of students by subtest, grade and subtest score. Data can be aggregated at the State, Subgrantee, District, Public and Non-public School level. Performance levels and grades display based upon the available data.	How many 3rd graders scored "Proficient" last year on the ELPA21 assessment?
ASMT 1.5.6 - ELPA21 Screener List	This report is designed to show a list of students' ELPA21 Screener results for the selected organization in a list format. EdInsight has ELPA21 Screener data beginning with the 2018-2019 school year.	What were the ELPA21 Screener assessment results at my building last year?
ASMT 1.6.1 - Student Growth List	There are two types of growth measures reflected in this report: 1) Iowa Testing Program (ITP) expected growth, and 2) growth towards college and career readiness. 1) ITP expected growth can be defined as year-over-year gain on an Iowa Assessment test score compared to the standard growth observed by ITP for students in the 35-65 percentile range. This is sometimes referred to as "making a year of academic growth in a year's time". 2) College and career ready growth can be defined as year-over-year progress toward a college- and career ready benchmark, provided by ITP, by grade 12. If the calculated annual gain necessary to stay on target toward	Did my 8th-grade students demonstrate "expected" growth in Math, and who were the students who did not display growth in Math?

ASMT 1.6.2 - Student Growth with Proficiency	This report produces a student level list of data, with two visualizations that describe students' growth and proficiency metrics on a scatterplot chart. One chart plots these measures based on the prior year cut points; the second chart plots the measures based on the target year cut points.	What percent of students in my high school were proficient in Reading but did not display growth in Reading?
ASMT 1.6.3 - School Growth and Proficiency	This report displays growth and proficiency information aggregated to the school building. Depending on a user's security level, the report may be run to include schools within an AEA, or a School District.	Which high schools in my AEA did not demonstrate either growth or proficiency in Math this year?
ASMT 1.6.4 - Student Growth Percentile List	This report provides the user with a student level list which contains data reflecting student growth percentiles (SGPs), scale scores and proficiency (where available) for the subjects of Math and Reading. A student growth percentile (SGP) describes a student's growth compared to other students with similar prior test scores (their academic peers). It also demonstrates a student's growth and academic progress, even if she/he is not yet meeting the proficiency benchmark.	What growth did my students demonstrate in 2018-2019?
EQTY 2.1/2.2 - AEA/District Equity Report	For district level and higher users with small cell size access, the purpose of the report is to examine Student, Employment and Course data for the purposes of reporting race, ethnicity and employment equity in the State, AEA and District. EQTY 2.1.1 - District Curriculum with Building	This report provides curriculum data for the selected School Year and District grouped by Course and School Building. Use this report in conjunction with the EQTY 2.1 - District Equity Report when School Building- level counts are helpful to Equity review.	What is the breakdown of courses by building within my district?
EQTY 2.3 - State Attendance Center Enrollment	This report contains State level Attendance data similar in structure and definition to the EQTY 2.1 and EQTY 2.2 reports.	What are the state aggregate values for student attendance center enrollments? (Often used for



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		comparative purposes in conjunction with a District-level EQTY 2.1 or AEA-level EQTY 2.2 report).
SI 2.5 - School Improvement Data Report	This report allows users to display district-level data on many different topics that are commonly reviewed during school improvement site visits. When available, five years of historical data are displayed in the report.	What is the projected enrollment for this district?
APR 4.1 - Student Achievement	Each year a school or school district is required to submit an annual progress report to the local community, AEA, and Iowa Department of Education. APR 4.1 provides the student achievement information for that progress report. Counts and percentages of students broken down by proficiency levels, ethnicities and program indicators are displayed. Additional note: For the 2018-2019 school year, the statewide assessment changed from the Iowa Assessments to the Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP), and contain major changes. Data from the ISASP should not be compared to prior years' assessment results. Please refer to the Report Definition for information regarding the interpretation of the data.	Which 8th grade subgroup has the largest achievement gap in reading, math and science?
APR 4.2 - Annual Progress Report Data	This report provides student achievement information for the selected district or school for the past five years and is designed to provide the public with information from the State Annual Progress Report (APR) specifically as it applies to student achievement on standardized tests for the subjects of Reading, Mathematics and Science.	How has proficiency for a particular grade or cohort of students changed over time?
ENR 5.1 - Student SRI Demographics	This report displays demographic information for the selected student(s) based on the SRI (formerly EASIER) data collection.	What have the historical demographic values been for a selected student (as collected by the SRI system)?
CURR 6.1 - Curriculum Accreditation Report	Displays the number of Carnegie Units that are offered and taught in a building and allows for comparison with the State, AEA, or enrollment category. Comparison groups are configured by school type so that regular high schools, alternative schools, and charter schools are compared separately. Users are able to drill through and view details	What subject areas offer the most courses and credit hours?

CURR 6.2 - Curriculum Accreditation Report Detail	Displays all the courses that are offered and taught in the referenced building, grouped by accreditation area and course name. (initially use the UTIL9.2 report to identify schools of similar size)
SPED 7.1 - AEA Part B Special Education Data Profiles	The Special Education AEA Profiles Report allows users to display AEA-level data on many of the special education indicators that are required based on Iowa's State Performance Report that is required by the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) under the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) of 2004. Annual outcomes and targets are displayed graphically for each indicator.	How are the students in my AEA with IEPs performing on the Iowa assessments?
SPED 7.2 - District Part B Special Education Data Profiles	The Special Education District Profiles Report allows users to display district-level data on many of the special education indicators that are required based on Iowa's State Performance Report that is required by the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) under the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) of 2004. Annual outcomes and targets are displayed graphically for each indicator.	What percentage of students with IEPs in this district is graduating in 4 years?
UTIL 9.2 - School and District Comparison Report	UTIL 9.2 allows the user to find comparable schools or districts in terms of size (enrollment), and/or demographic variables. IND 11.1 - Graduation Report	The Graduation Report provides users with current and historical graduation rates aggregated at the levels of State, AEA, District, and Building. IND 11.2 - Dropout Report	This report defines count and content of dropouts at the State, AEA and District Level from 2005-2006 school year to current. With disaggregations and trending, this report will provide insight into the quantity and content of dropouts.	What was the count of Male dropouts compared to Female dropouts in my school district?
FIN 14.1 - School District Financial Report Card	This report has moved to the public site for Iowa School Performance Profiles (https://www.iaschoolperformance.gov/ECP/Home/Index).
