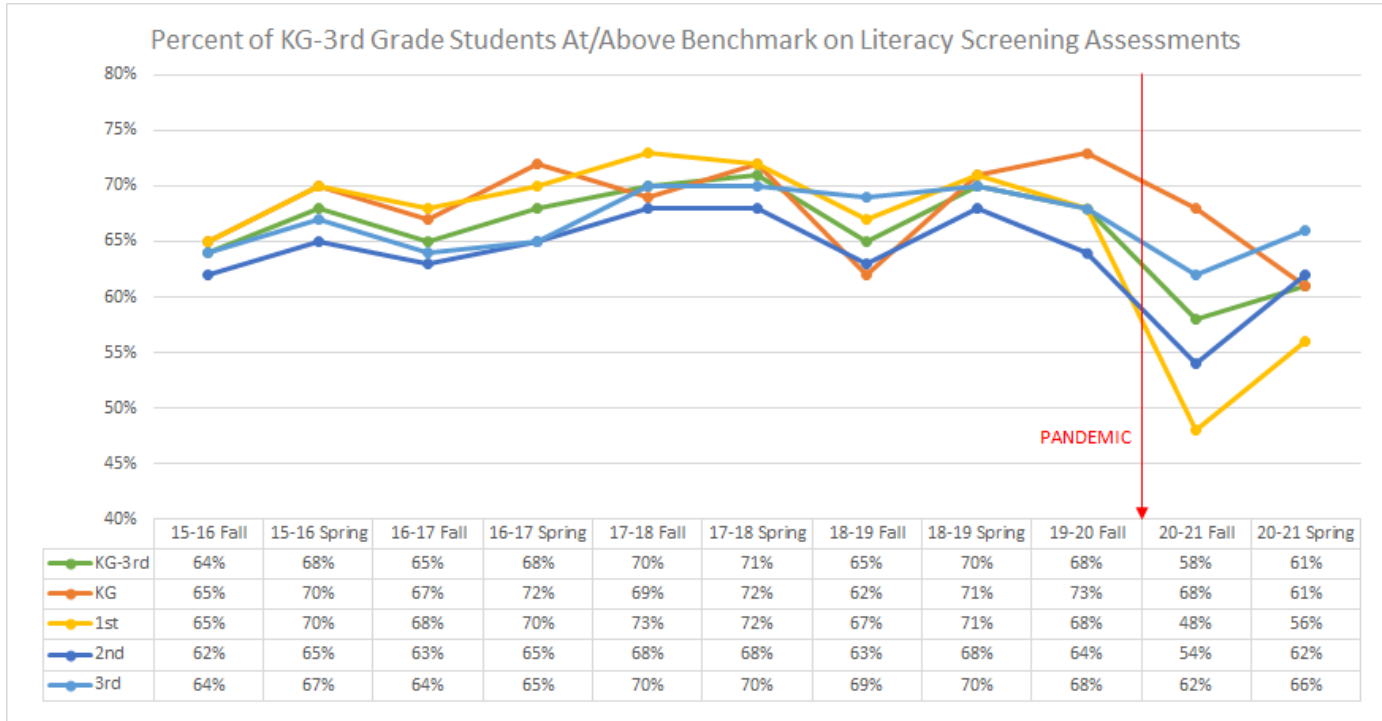

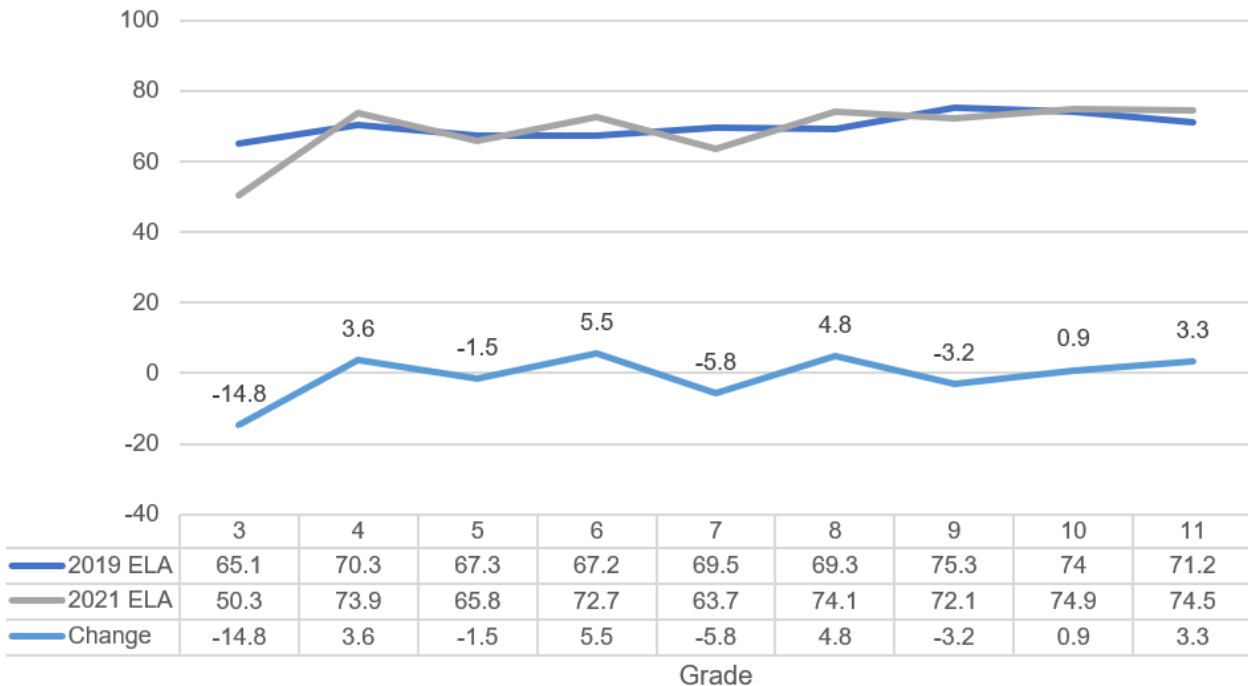
Figure 1: Early Literacy Screening Data 2015-16 to 2020-2021

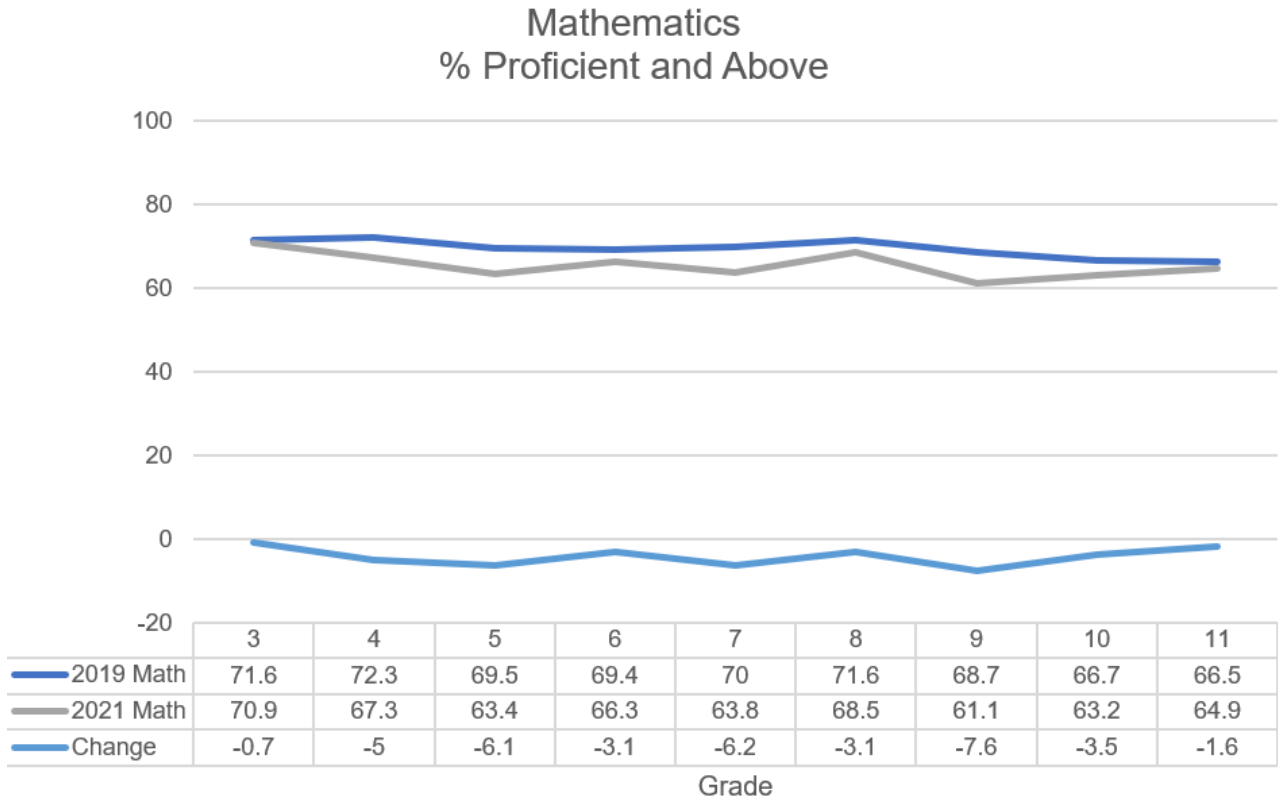
Figure 2: Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) 2019 and 2021, All Students

English Language Arts % Proficient and Above



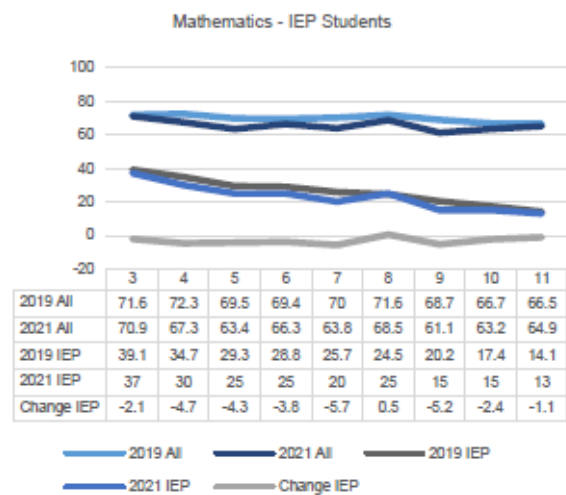
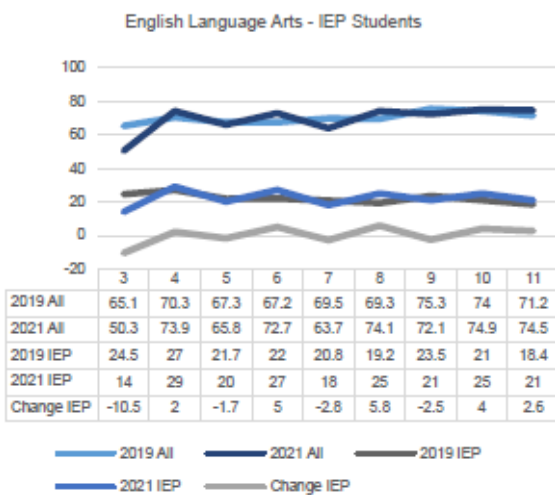
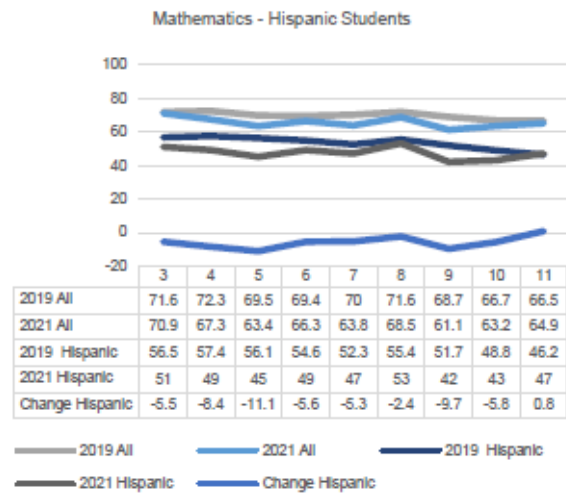
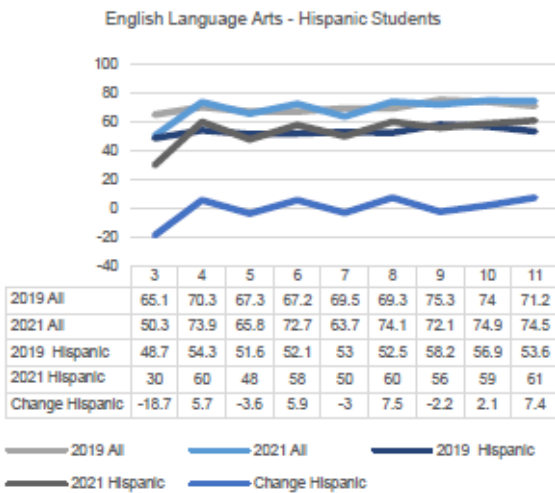
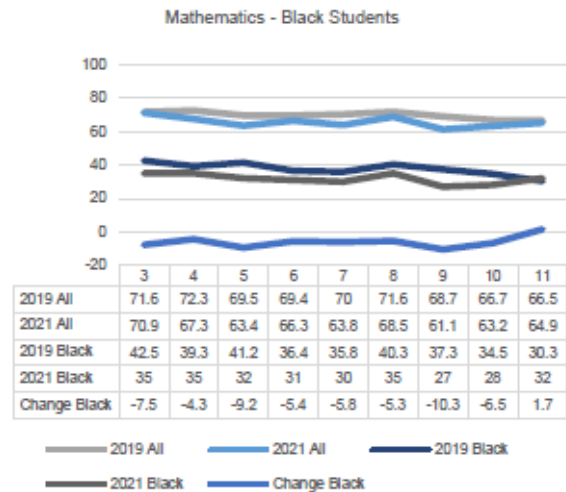
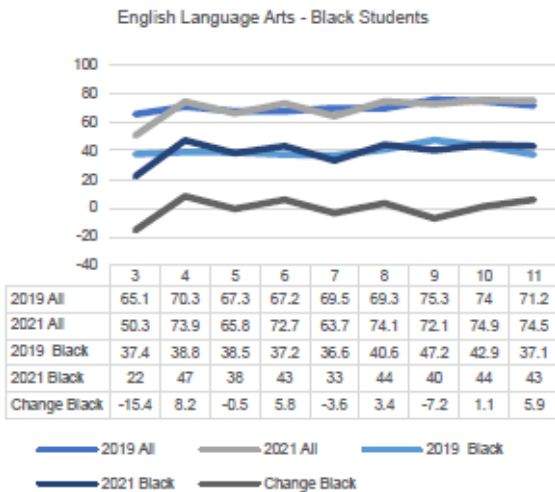
