Federal Title IV, Part B 21CCLC funds are initially awarded to the Iowa Department of Education as a qualifying State Education Agency (SEA). The Department then awards funding to qualifying subgrantees for a period of up to 5 years. Local education agencies (LEAs) and various types of nonprofit organizations may apply for funding, but for-profit organizations are not eligible.
