National Board Certification Subsidy Instructions Deadline to Apply: April 30 of each year

Funds are available to offset the \$1,900 registration fee to become National Board Certified (NBC) through the Iowa Department of Education. First-time NBC candidates can be subsidized for up to one-half of the fee. The funds will be prorated if the number of applicants exceeds the available funding. Subsidy funds cannot be allocated to a candidate who has previously utilized subsidy funding. The subsidy fee will not be paid until candidate has registered for two components and the deadline to withdraw from the National Board Certification process (April 30, 2021) has passed. To apply, please review the following steps:

Step 1: Review the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards (NBPTS) eligibility criteria at https://www.nbpts.org/

- **Step 2:** Review the following Iowa Department of Education's criteria.
 - Teachers eligible for the registration fee reimbursement program shall meet all of the following qualifications:
 - a) The individual has all qualifications required by NBPTS for application for certification.
 - b) The individual is a teacher.
 - c) The individual is employed by a school district in Iowa.
 - d) The individual receives a salary as a classroom teacher.
 - e) The individual completes the department's application process, which includes submitting verification of NBC registration for a minimum of two components.
 - f) The individual has not received reimbursement from this program at any previous time.
 - g) Apply for the fee reimbursement within one year of registration for NBPTS.

It is possible for teachers residing out-of-state to qualify for the financial incentives if they meet the above qualifications. Teachers are not required to be lowa residents. They are required to be teaching students in an lowa school district.

Step 3: Apply to be an NBC candidate online at https://www.nbpts.org/ (Be sure to print a copy of your application, as you will need to send a copy to the Iowa Department of Education.)

Note: Be sure to include your email address on the application form. All correspondence will be done by email.

Step 4: To begin candidacy and in order for the Iowa Department of Education to pay the subsidy fee, you will need to pay the registration fees for two or more components before the April 30 deadline. There is also a \$75 processing charge required at the time of application submission. This non-refundable fee is separate from the registration fee and is assessed each year candidates apply for components until certification is earned.

Do not send any money to the Iowa Department of Education. Follow the NBPTS procedures for payment.
