 - BIO163 works for this transfer major
 - Transfer to Iowa
 - Iowa will allow for one substitution
 - They have not heard back yet from Faculty regarding this course
 - **Decision:** Wait until Iowa replies back; Heather will update the group
 - Elementary Education Transfer Major (All Regents)
 - Addition of EDU-810 (Field Experience) as a Field Experience option
 - Description

 - Will count towards this transfer major

 - Transfer to UNI

 - Will work for this transfer major
 - This will also work for the Secondary Education transfer major
 - Transfer to Iowa
 - They this this will transfer
 - **Decision:** Wait on adding this course to these two transfer majors

 - History Transfer Major (All Regents)
 - Addition of HIS-126 (West and the World I: Ancient to Medieval), HIS-127 (West and the World II: Medieval to Enlightenment), and HIS-128 (West and the World III: Enlightenment to Modern) as Western History I & II options

- Transfer to ISU
 - HIS126 + HIS127 + HIS128 articulates with HIST 201 + HIST 202 (i.e. student has to take all three courses)
 - HIST 201 and HIST 202 are part of history transfer major so this will work
- Transfer to UNI
 - These courses will work for the history electives that are required for the degree
- Transfer to Iowa
 - There are direct equivalents for all three courses
 - This will work, but will need an advising note (stating that they only need two of the courses) – Tom will send Heather the advising note
- **Decision:** To add these courses to the History Transfer Major
