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- Additions to Transfer Majors
 - o Social Work Transfer Major (UNI and SUI)
 - Addition of BIO-163 (Essentials of A&P) as a Human Biology option
 - Transfer to Iowa
 - UI will accept this course in the discipline framework but with advising note
 - Advising note: The UI prefers Human Biology, will accept Anatomy and Physiology I or Essentials of Anatomy and Physiology if all natural science gen eds are fulfilled prior to transfer to UI.
 - **Update**: This TM has been updated.
 - History Transfer Major (All Regents)
 - Addition of HIS-126 (West and the World I: Ancient to Medieval), HIS-127 (West and the World II: Medieval to Enlightenment), and HIS-128 (West and the World III: Enlightenment to Modern) as Western History I & II options
 - **Update**: U of Iowa advising note was added and this transfer major has been updated
 - Elementary Education Transfer Major (All Regents)
 - Addition of EDU-810 (Field Experience) as a Field Experience option
 - Transfer to ISU
 - EDU810 articulates with EDU280
 - Will count towards this transfer major
 - This will also work for the Secondary Education transfer major if EDU280 is in the major
 - Transfer to UNI
 - EDU810 at Kirkwood does transfer as field experience
 - Will work for this transfer major
 - This will also work for the Secondary Education transfer major
 - Transfer to Iowa
 - They said that this will transfer but with advising note
 - Advising note: Students need completed verification of a post high school 10-hour field experience prior to admission
 - Will also work for secondary education (email on 4-20-2021)
 - <u>Decision to make</u>: Add EDU-810 (Field Experience) as a Field Experience option to both the Elementary Education and Secondary Education Transfer Majors
 - **Notes:** This is the only Field Experience course for KCC (was already in the state curriculum system—it's not a new course)
 - **Decision:** Add EDU-810 as a Field Experience option for the Elementary Education and Secondary Education Transfer Majors

Transfer Major Updates

- Graphic Design and Graphic Communications/Technology
 - Still working on drafts of the frameworks
 - Graphic Communications is ready to be sent to the Discipline Framework Subcommittee to review
 - Graphic Design will most likely not be done until the fall
- Digital Media (UNI) discipline framework approval
 - Deadline was April 4 for colleges to respond (was sent to CAOs)

 - o **Decision to make**: Approve Digital Media discipline framework
 - Notes: IWCC and HCC have MMS-135 (Media Writing) but it's not listed in the framework
 - <u>Decision:</u> Approve the Digital Media transfer major pending the addition of MMS-134 (Media Writing) to the Digital Media discipline framework element
 - Motion: Don Waltenberger (IHCC)
 - Second: Jenny Kruger (IWCC)
 - Vote: All approved
- Update to the Discipline Framework approval process
 - o DF subcommittee → Institutions → TMSC
 - Iowa Administrative Code 281–21.3(2): The discipline framework shall be developed and adopted by a statewide committee convened by the department.
 - Proposal: DF subcommittee → TMSC
 - <u>Decision to make</u>: Approve discipline framework approval process
 - MMS-134 (Media Writing) add to writing for Digital Media element
 - <u>Decision:</u> Approve more streamlined process for approving transfer major discipline frameworks
 - Motion: Jenny Kruger (IWCC)
 - Second: Darin Moeller (WITCC)
 - Vote: All approved
 - Heather will make sure this new process is added to the updated version of the Program Approval Guide

- Criminal Justice group met on April 19th
 - Programs at the regents have changed slightly since this transfer major was first approved.
 - Several colleges states that they have been advising students into the AA instead of the transfer major
 - Kelly Friesleben is setting up meetings with advisors/student services officers regarding this

- Heather is going to reach out to the regents to see if there are other courses that can be added to the framework.
- Notes:
 - There has been lots of turnover and burnout at the colleges
 - The AA is sometimes a better option sometimes based on credit already taken (UNI offers BAS- confuses students)
 - Need to continue to educate and communicate
- Survey for Business and Education Transfer Majors
 - o Results:

 - Notes:
 - It was recommended to get Business group together
 - At Iowa State, math is needed to prepare students for Business (those on general AA degree would not be on track). Also, MKT is junior level course so they'd be taking it twice
 - University of lowa said the same thing
 - Heather will get names from CAOs so that Business group can meet in Fall
 - It was suggested to add a rationale to future transfer majors and current transfer majors so that people know why certain courses were necessary
 - At lowa State, ECE170 does not transfer for Developmental Psych (it isn't consistently substituted) - their preference is to take the other version -ISU wants to remove it completely from the discipline framework
 - For the Education TMs, Heather will email discipline frameworks to regents to look at and add rationale
 - Then have Education meet as well in the fall (will review after regents look for it)
 - Heather will get names from CAOs
