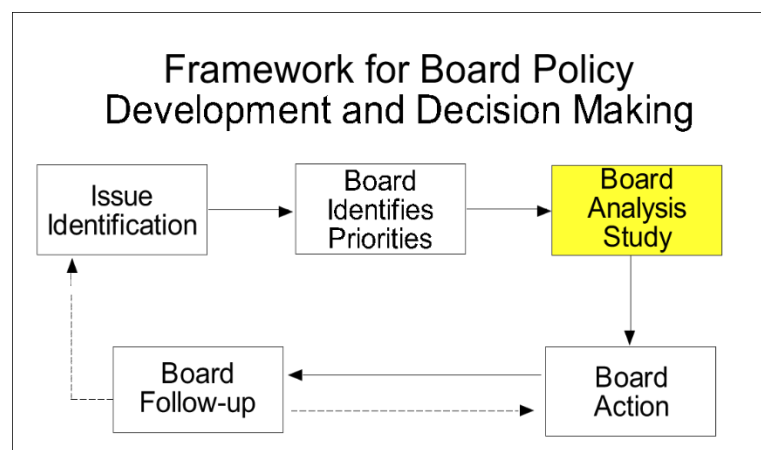

Background: The Iowa Department of Education (Department) collects data that is used annually for the federal and state educator shortage reports. Collaboration between the educator quality team and the Bureau of Information Analysis has strengthened the Department's data collection capabilities. The expanded and improved data will demonstrate geographic needs and inform efforts to enhance the state's teacher pipeline. Updated reports will be available December 30, 2023.
