

# Individuals with Disabilities Act Part C FFY24 (2024-25) AEA Data Profiles

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## Purpose

The Iowa Department of Education (Department) has designated each Area Education Agency (AEA), as an Early ACCESS Grantee, with the fiscal and legal obligation to ensure the Early ACCESS Integrated System of Early Intervention Services, Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Part C, are provided statewide. The components of Iowa’s general supervision system ensure each AEA meets the IDEA requirements with an emphasis on improving early intervention results for infants and toddlers and their families.

Each AEA is monitored annually to ensure each AEA meets IDEA Part C requirements and is improving early intervention results and functional outcomes for all infants and toddlers with disabilities and their families. The Department utilizes the ACHIEVE system to generate data files, reports and documentation annually for the period of July 1 through June 30 of the state fiscal year for each AEA as part of Iowa’s System of General Supervision.

## State Performance Plan and Annual Performance Report

States are required by the IDEA to develop and submit a state performance plan (SPP) every six years, reporting on the performance of indicators against the targets set in an annual performance report (APR). The current six year SPP/APR cycle began with the submission of the SPP for the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2020. The *AEA Data Profiles for IDEA Part C*, referred to as Early ACCESS, reports data profiles on the indicators for the state and each AEA.

### Indicator C1: Timely Provision of Early Intervention Services

Data Source & Time Period of Data: ACHIEVE; Jan. 1, 2025 through June 30, 2025 (FFY24)

#### Measurement

Percent of infants and toddlers with Individual Family Service Plans (IFSPs) who receive the early intervention services on their IFSPs in a timely manner.

- Early intervention services are considered timely if initiated within 30 calendar days from the date in which a written parental Consent for Early ACCESS Services was obtained.
- Data is based on the actual number of days, not the average, between the date of Consent for Early ACCESS Services and the date specified on the IFSP service log for provision of the first service.

## Indicator C3: Early Childhood Outcomes

Data Source & Time Period of Data: ACHIEVE; January 1, 2025 through June 30, 2025 (FFY24)

### Measurement

Percent of infants and toddlers with IFSPs who demonstrate improved Early Childhood Outcomes (ECO) in the following areas:

- A. Positive social-emotional skills (including social relationships);
- B. Acquisition and use of knowledge and skills (including early language/communication);
- C. Use of appropriate behaviors to meet their needs.

### Measurement

Percent of infants and toddlers exited Early ACCESS during the reporting period in the following progress categories:

- a. Did not improve functioning;
- b. Improved functioning but not sufficient to move nearer to functioning comparable to same-aged peers;

- c. Improved functioning to a level nearer to same-aged peers but did not reach it;
- d. Improved functioning to reach a level comparable to same-aged peers; or,
- e. Maintained functioning at a level comparable to same-aged peers.

Iowa uses an ECO summary process when children exit Early ACCESS to determine children’s current functioning and progress compared to same-aged peers while receiving early intervention services. The data from the progress categories, a through e, determine the two summary statements for each ECO area.

## Indicator C4: Family Involvement

Data Source & Time Period of Data: ACHIEVE; July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025 (FFY24)

### Measurement

Percent of families participating in Early ACCESS who report early intervention services have helped the family:

- A. Know their rights;
  - B. Effectively communicate their children’s needs;
  - C. Help their children develop and learn.
- The ACHIEVE data system will automatically send the Early ACCESS Family Involvement Survey to families of all children with either an annual IFSP meeting or exiting Early ACCESS between July 1 - June 30 of the current reporting year.
    - For each measurement (A, B, C) which is either missing data or a “Don’t Know” response for more than two questions, the system will not calculate a response and the data will not be included in the reporting.
  - The Early ACCESS Family Involvement Survey data were analyzed by race/ethnicity; gender; and geographic location, based on school district locale size, to determine the extent to which families who

responded to the survey were representative of the demographics of infants and toddlers enrolled in Iowa's Early ACCESS Services.

- If the percent of the Family Involvement Survey responses are within +/- 3 percentage points of the population, it is considered representative. Differences which are greater are considered over- or underrepresented, respectively.

Data Source & Time Period of Data: ACHIEVE; January 1, 2025 through June 30, 2025 (FFY24)

### Measurement

Percent of toddlers exiting Early ACCESS with timely transition planning for whom the [Early ACCESS Grantee] has:

- Developed an IFSP with transition steps and services at least 90 days (and, at the discretion of all parties, not more than nine months) prior to the toddler's third birthday;
- Notified the [Iowa Department of Education] and the [AEA Special Education IDEA Part B] where the toddler resides, at least 90 days prior to the toddler's third birthday, of toddlers potentially eligible for special education, IDEA Part B;
  - Iowa Department of Education is the Lead Agency for IDEA Part C.
  - Comprehensive Child Find for Special Education, IDEA Part B, is the statutory responsibility of the resident Area Education Agency.
- Conducted transition meeting, with approval of the family, at least 90 days (and, at the discretion of all parties, not more than nine months) prior to the toddler's third birthday for toddlers potentially eligible for special education, IDEA Part B.

Requirements of Timely Transition Meeting:

- A transition meeting must be held in conjunction with an initial, periodic review, annual review or modification of an IFSP.
- The purpose of the Meeting Notice must include Early ACCESS Transition Planning.
- A transition meeting must be held at least 90 days (and, at the discretion of all parties, not more than nine months) prior to the toddler’s third birthday.
- A transition meeting for toddlers potentially eligible for special education, with approval of the family, must include an AEA Special Education Child Find representative.
